Welcome to **transition**, a smart way to get the most out of your perimeter space. This guide is intended to help you understand what **transition** is and how **transition** works.

transition is a modular, track-mounted storage system that give you the flexibility to reconfigure each module as your needs change. Not only can you add modules, but you can reconfigure the nature of the modules you already have.

Put in perspective...in **elements_{bmt}**®, a shelving unit is always a shelving unit. With **transition**, the same shelving unit can be open storage, closed storage, drawers, lockers or markerboard. This leopard **CAN** change its spots.

You can begin with a “Starter” shelving unit kit and as many “Adder” kits as you need. You can move and remove shelves, add doors, drawers and/or marker boards – whatever you need. You can add new kits. It is totally repurpose-able. Because it’s track-mounted, it can all be relocated to another (track) location (*room, building, city, etc*).

This guide contains drawings, diagrams, examples and a pricer to help you configure and define your transition needs.

“Vertical Height of Starter & Adder Shelf Unit Kits” shows the variety of base unit and upper unit kits by height and also indicates door handle locations and drawers.

“Starter and Adder Unit Widths” indicates the variety of widths available for all base and upper units. *Add 2” for starters and 1” for each adder for the end panels.*

“Starter & Adder Unit Heights” shows the available height of each base and upper unit in relationship to the upper and lower track.

***It is important to understand that each Starter and Adder kit is available in both 13” and 19” depths!**

“Base & Upper Doors” and **“Base (Tall) Doors”** indicate the sizes of each of the available doors. *...get the idea?*

“Drawers” indicates the height and width of the available drawers. **Drawers are available in 13” and 19” depths!**

“Marker Boards” indicates the height and width of the... *C’mon, really? You get it, right? Does somebody really have to tell you that take-out coffee is hot? Of course not! You’re smart, right? Just look at the examples on the “Examples” page. No problem, right?*

OK, I gave you a blank grid sheet to draw out ideas. Print a new one each time or make copies. *Did I really have to tell you that? ...I didn’t think so.* All the kits and accessories are in the price sheets. There’s even an à la carte (à la Parts) component list that includes all the stuff in the kits and a few other things like locker shelves with hooks, shelving for inside and outside corners, longer marker board track, and the like.


There are a few “gotchas” to look out for...



1. Add 2” to the published shelf width (*model number*) for starters and 1” to each adder for the end panels.
2. You will always need 1 less marker board than you have units. For example: If you have three 30” units, you can use one or two 30” marker boards – NOT three.
3. Marker boards are ALWAYS located at the top
4. Make sure your drawers and doors fit your unit space and shelf space.
5. Upper doors can be located at the top or in the middle – NOT at the bottom
6. Base doors can be located at the bottom or in the middle – NOT at the top
7. Doors and drawers CANNOT be located in the shelf space directly beneath Marker Boards
8. There are some items that cannot be located directly above or below one another. *You’ll figure it out.*



VERTICAL HEIGHT OF STARTER & ADDER SHELF UNIT KITS





STARTER & ADDER UNIT WIDTHS

The **BOLD> number** represents the interior dimension - the shelf width. For outside dimension, add 2" for a starter and 1" for each adder to account for end panels.




STARTER & ADDER UNIT HEIGHTS






BASE (TALL) DOORS

(2) 84" x 30" x 19" Adder Units

...Now add (2) 42" x 30" Marker Boards

...Now remove marker boards and 4 shelves and add a work surface shelf.

Start with Open Storage...



(2) 84" x 24" x 19" Starter Units
(1) 36" x 24" x 19" Starter Unit
(1) 36" x 24" x 19" Adder Unit

...you can add Drawers



...Now add (2) 14" x 24" x 19" Utility Drawers

...or add Doors...or...



...Now remove drawers and add (2) 30" x 24" Double Doors
